

Health and Safety Committee

Red Cross Tent Volunteers

Volunteers will staff the Red Cross booth/tent to assist with minor health and emergency needs, under the supervision of a trained professional. Volunteers must complete Red Cross Training basic first aid, CPR, and blood borne pathogens (10-15 hours).

Information Booth Workers

Volunteers will provide information and basic supplies, maps, agendas, first-aid kits, pens, paper, and miscellaneous items to campers and visitors.

Volunteer Center Attendant

Check in volunteers, distribute volunteer shirts and kits, answer volunteer questions, and in general provide support for Canoe Journey volunteers.

Elder Hospitality Host

Provide information and assistance to elders attending Journey activities.

Maintenance Committee

Setup Help

Assist with setup of tables for serving and eating of meals. Will also help set up campsites and other venues as needed.

Garbage/Recycle Help

Answer questions at composting bins during and after meals to ensure all compostable items are properly disposed.

General Maintenance Support

Assist Maintenance staff with general clean up and maintenance needs, minor table straightening after meals, and jobs assigned as needed.

Food Committee

Servers

Volunteers will serve in two capacities: 1.) dish up food for people at scheduled meals and 2.) serve tables of Elders, Canoe Pullers, and Skippers.

Runners/Bus Tables

Volunteers will refill serving trays and bus tables.

Sous Chef/Kitchen Help

Volunteers will assist Lead Cooks with kitchen duties, including food preparation and dish washing.

Camping Committee

Campsite Setup

Volunteers will assist with preparation and setup of campgrounds and sites.

Campground Monitors/Support

Volunteers will oversee and support campgrounds, including general condition of campground, checking showers, campsite needs, clean up, general safety.

Merchandise booth

Volunteers will provide direct sales (cashier and information) to Canoe Journey participants and guests. Retail experience or customer service training preferred.

Giveaways Committee

Volunteers will assist with distribution of gifts to visitors and honored guests.
